

#### Points to note...

- The subjects that the pupils choose for S3 will continue into S4.
- Pupils will be allowed to choose their best six courses rather than have to choose from each curricular area.
- S3 Tasters will be included into the curriculum which will allow pupils to have a variety of experiences which may lead to wider achievement qualifications in S4.
- Pupils will have more opportunities to increase their meta and life skills to help prepare them for life after Irvine Royal.






